Separate sealed BIDS for the **Downtown Summerville Streetscape Washington Street, Project No. PI 0010702** will be received by the **City of Summerville** at the office of the **City of Summerville, City Hall, 120 Georgia Avenue, Summerville, GA 30747** until **5:00 P.M., EDST**, on **Tuesday, June 19, 2018**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project is being funded by the Georgia Department of Transportation. All applicable specifications and requirements of the Georgia Department Transportation will have to be met.

All Bidders must be properly licensed by the State of Georgia Board of Construction Industry, and must be listed on the Georgia Department of Transportation approved Contractors or Sub-Contractors List as published.

A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the total bid amount must be submitted with the bid, subject to the form and conditions provided in the "Information for Bidders".

Bidders must furnish with their bid the following certifications and affidavits:

- Certification of Bidder Regarding Equal Employment Opportunity
- Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension and Other Responsibility Matters

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The City of Summerville reserves the right to waive any informality and accept or refuse any and all bids. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 120 days after the active date of the bid opening.

The City of Summerville in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d-42 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, 2013 Edition, GDOT Supplemental Specifications Book 2016 Edition, and applicable Special Provisions apply to this project. The applicable GDOT Specifications govern over any conflicting requirements that may be found in the Agreement, Supplemental General Provisions, and General Conditions.

The proposed streetscape project will be approximately 485' of grass median landscaping, concrete sidewalks and driveways, trees, irrigation system, curb and gutters along both sides of Washington Street, storm drainage inlets and piping, installation of decorative poles to hang plants and banners, benches, trash receptacles, stormwater BMP's, and paving and striping of modified travel lanes.

Completion time of the project is 120 calendar days.

Bidder Qualification:

- Bidders submitting bids over \$2,000,000 shall be prequalified with the GDOT.
- Bidders submitting bids \$2,000,000 or less shall be prequalified or registered subcontractors with the GDOT.
- DBE goals for this project are **13%**.

A performance BOND is required as per Section 103.05. This results in a performance BOND of 100% of the contract and amount and a payment BOND of 110% of the contract amount, with a corporate surety approved by the OWNER, will be required for the faithful performance of the CONTRACT.

The last day to submit questions concerning the project will be Monday, June 11, 2018.
