TO: ALL PLAN HOLDERS AND INTERESTED PARTIES

SUBJECT: Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents are hereby amended, modified, and changed as follows:

I. Reference Par V – Special Conditions

- A. In Table of Contents, Page V-1, add Part No. 14 to read Purchases of American-Made Equipment and Products.
- B. In Paragraph 2, Page V-2, the work schedule is hereby modified to prohibit work on all holidays, Saturdays and Sundays.
- C. In paragraph 13.E.5, bid item description for Superpave Bituminous Wearing Surface, the bid price will be adjusted according to standard ALDOT practice based on the Asphalt Index and Fuel Index.
- D. Add the following paragraph 14:

14. Purchases of American-Made Equipment and Products

- A. The Contractor agrees to abide by the Buy America law as identified in 23 USC 313 and comply with the Federal Highway Administration's (FHWA) regulatory policy regarding Buy America identified in 23 CFR 635.410.
- B. Included in this requirement is that for all steel or iron materials used in the project, all manufacturing processes, including application of a coating, must be performed in the United States.
- C. Contractor shall be required to submit a certification on company letterhead with each pay request that indicates compliance with Buy America requirements and that all materials provided on the project comply with Buy America.
- D. Attached is a Sample Certification Letter included on Page ADM1-3

II. Reference Plans, Sheet 4

- A. On Detail C, remove the words "POWDER COATED" from the Detail title. Powder coating of handrails is not required.

III. The following Pre-Bid Minutes are Included by Addendum and made a part of the Contract Documents.

- A. A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Wednesday November 10, 2018 at the Lake Guntersville State Park Lodge at 9:00 a.m. James Payton with Ladd Environmental Consultants, Inc. moderated the conference. An attendance list is attached on page ADM1-4.
- B. A general description of the project was presented including that the total disturbed acreage is less than 1 acre (plan sheets 1 and 2), playground equipment and a bench shown on the plans has been relocated by the Owner, traffic control is the contractor's responsibility (Part V Special Conditions, paragraph 10), and required coordination with the zip line operator (Spec 01039, paragraph 1.03.J – 1.03.M). Ken Thomas of State Parks discussed Buy America requirements. Refer to paragraph III above.
- C. A question was asked about Powder Coating requirements on handrails. No powder coating is required. The wording on plan sheet 4, Detail C is modified in paragraph IV above.
- D. The project area was walked by all in attendance. It was pointed out that paved areas may not be used by the contractor for parking or storage (Spec 01500, paragraph 1.15.C).
